## 1. INTRODUCTION

The Harry Gwala Development Agency is an entity of the Harry Gwala District Municipality established to serve as a special purpose vehicle to augment economic growth of the district, thereby realising the developmental path of the District in the Provincial, National and broader context. Located within the picturesque landscapes of KwaZulu-Natal, South Africa, the Harry Gwala district boasts a rich tapestry of cultural heritage and natural attractions.

## 2. BACKGROUND

The Harry Gwala Development Agency (HGDA) was established in 2014 as a municipal entity of the Harry Gwala District Municipality to support local economic development initiatives within the district. Since its establishment, the Agency has occupied its current premises for administrative operations and service delivery functions. Over time, the existing ablution facilities and sanitary fittings have deteriorated due to age, continuous usage, and normal wear and tear. This has resulted in plumbing defects, persistent odours associated with pipe leakages, and reduced functionality of restroom infrastructure. HGDA therefore intends to undertake the renovation and upgrading of its ablution facilities through the removal and replacement of existing sanitary fittings with new water-efficient and compliant installations to improve hygiene standards, accessibility, and operational efficiency.
